## Meeting Notes from AUG Meeting

### Events:

- **SEPT 21**—Silver Dollar's Mustang Day. This is an annual event, sponsored by our track. This event is a fun day for all Mustang Lovers. Although we have two classes for eliminations, most of what we will be doing is open track test & tune for street cars who just want to see how fast their cars will go in the quarter mile. The Fastest Mustang Shootout is open to anyone who is Ford or Ford powered; two qualifying runs; guaranteed purse & a trophy. The ET Race is for street legal Mustangs; must have mufflers; slicks are allowed; 1st round buyback; guaranteed purse & a trophy. The car show is a fun event with the winner receiving a one year membership in the NMRA (National Mustang Racing Association). We are closely affiliated with the NMRA and host one of their National Events every April. Judging is done by totally "unqualified" judges who usually pick the car they think is the "coolest" or their favorite color or is just pretty! Admission for car and driver is \$25, which allows him/her to compete in an eliminator, the car show or just have track time only. Spectator admission is \$10.
- **Oct 19**—Pumpkin Run slash Road Rally to the mountains instead of regular meeting.
- **NOV 2**—Second GRMC Fall Open Track Day. Sign up now, spots limited. Need workers as well. More detail on Website.

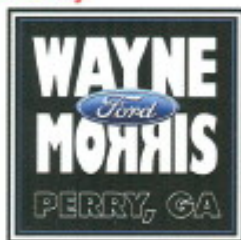
